



A Worship Study Guide for Individuals, Groups & Families

November 6, 2022: **Faith**

- In every worship service, we sing songs to God that help us better understand the sermon. This week, we sang “*Jesus, What a Friend for Sinners.*” [Listen to the song](#) or [read the lyrics](#). This hymn heaps up descriptions of Who Jesus is and what He has done for us. **Which description strikes you today? Why?**
- This week, **we heard from [Brigitte Bakiala](#)** who shared how Jesus met her, just as He met with Nicodemus. **Brigitte shared how Jesus met her through His church, and that [ministry to those in need is love for Jesus](#). Have you ever known this kind of fellowship with Jesus in ministry or need?**
- The first Sunday of each month, we bring the children’s of church together for a Children’s Message. **How would you explain “faith” to a child? (Remember that [Jesus seemed to like childlike faith](#).)**
- Every service at WEPC includes an Old Testament reading that serves as a companion to the sermon text. This week we read [Isaiah 26:1-4](#) and saw that faith and belief involves trust. **How do you need to trust the LORD in this season of life? What challenges do you face as you trust Him?**
- This week, Pastor Steve Shelby preached from [John 3:16-17](#) **What does Jesus mean by “believe in Him”?**
- **Pray that hearts at WEPC will be made new.** Ask Him for faith to believe that He so loved the world, that He gave His only Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have eternal life. Do you need to become a Christian? Be renewed as a follower of Jesus? To change, believe, or to repent? Hint: The answer is “Yes” and you can ask Jesus to meet you right now!
