



Descriptions of Member Volunteer Services

Greeter/Host -- Greeters stand at doors and welcome people with a smile and a bulletin. Host stand at the welcome table or coffee table and answer questions or give directions to visitors. *8:45-9:15 AM and 10:15-10:45 AM about once every 8 weeks*

Communion Prep -- Prepare communion elements in trays ahead of worship; assist the pastor and elders in distribution during the services, update communicant counts, then clean-up communion trays afterwards, and prepare clean trays for the next time. At least one Sunday of training is required. *8:15 AM-12:00 PM about once every 8 weeks.*

Coffee Chef -- The Coffee Chef is the hospitality early bird and doesn't mind working alone or with a buddy. Arrival is 8:00 AM on Sunday mornings. Make the coffee in the fellowship hall and deliver coffee in large carafes to the gallery (there is some "heavy lifting" involved with this service). Then keep up with the cups and condiments throughout the morning. Clean up after coffee making and make sure coffee is replenished for 2nd service. The trained coffee makers usually train a new volunteer on a Sunday morning. *8:00-11:00 AM about once every 8 weeks*

Food Pantry -- This job is for people who have a heart to serve those in need. Volunteers can either work in the pantry filling orders and stocking shelves, or can work face-to-face with food pantry visitors by finding out needs, talking with them, and praying for them. Being able to communicate in another language is a plus, but not necessary. *12-1 PM about once every 7 weeks*

Nursery Volunteer -- This volunteer serves as part of the Children's Ministry Team to care for children in the nursery, ages newborn to four-years-old. Some nursery jobs require a background check and training, but not all. *9 or 10:30 AM service every 4-6 weeks*

Children's Sunday School -- This volunteer serves as part of the Children's Ministry Team to teach or help children in Preschool Quest through 5th grade. Training and background check required. *9:00 service either every week or every other week*

Children's Worship -- This volunteer serves as part of the Children's Ministry Team to help teach worship to children in Preschool Quest through 2nd grade. Training and background check required. *10:30 AM either every week or every other week*

Youth Group (Sunday Morning) -- If you have a heart for leading teens, then this is the place for you. Help facilitate small groups for discussion and prayer. Currently 10:30-11:45 AM, but will eventually switch to 9-10:30 AM. Background check required. *Weekly*

Adult Sunday School Teacher -- Must be approved by church Elders to lead or host Adult Sunday School.

Worship Team -- This volunteer serves as part of the Worship Arts team to lead music during Sunday morning worship services. Musical skills & experience required, and our musicians come from a variety of diverse musical backgrounds. Interested volunteers will connect with the Worship Arts Director to determine volunteer needs. *9 & 10:30 AM services every 4-5 weeks*

Audio Tech -- This volunteer serves as part of the Worship Arts team to manage the sound during Sunday morning worship services, specifically the music teams and church leaders. Prior experience preferred, but not required. Interested volunteers will connect with the Worship Arts Director and Lead Sound Tech to determine volunteer needs. Extensive training required. *9 & 10:30 AM services every 4-5 weeks*

Video Tech -- This volunteer serves as part of the Worship Arts team to assemble and run the video slides to guide the church during Sunday morning worship services. Minimum training required. *9 & 10:30 AM services every 4-5 weeks*

Deacon Assistant -- Men and women, appointed by the Session, that assist the Deacons in serving those in need. Training required.

Elder -- Men who are elected, called, and ordained to oversee the spiritual life of WEPC.

Deacon -- Men who are elected, called, and ordained to serve the physical and spiritual needs of WEPC, as well as oversee the Mercy Ministry that serves our church and nearby community.
