### ***Citizens Await***

*This week, Pastor Steve Shelby preached from [Philippians 3:20-21](#)*

<sup>20</sup> But our citizenship is in heaven, and from it we await a Savior, the Lord Jesus Christ, <sup>21</sup> who will transform our lowly body to be like his glorious body, by the power that enables him even to subject all things to himself.

*For Further Discussion....*

- What **comes to mind** when you think of **heaven**?
- Like the Philippians, we live in this world while, at the same time, we are citizens of heaven. This as both already true, but not yet realized for us. It's tough to live in between. **Where in your life do you feel the tension of the “already” and the “not yet”?**
- How does remembering we are citizens of heaven explain why **we feel such deep longings** in life?
- When Jesus returns, our lowly bodies will **be transformed** to be **like His glorious body**. **What does that mean?**
- Paul is offering the **hope of the Gospel** to us in today's passage. Where do you need Jesus to **supply hope as you wait** in this life?
- **Pray together** in light of this week's passage.
