## This is Love

This week, Pastor Steve Shelby preached from II John 1:5-11

<sup>5</sup> And now I ask you, dear lady— not as though I were writing you a new commandment, but the one we have had from the beginning that we love one another. <sup>6</sup> And this is love, that we walk according to his commandments; this is the commandment, just as you have heard from the beginning, so that you should walk in it. <sup>7</sup> For many deceivers have gone out into the world, those who do not confess the coming of Jesus Christ in the flesh. Such a one is the deceiver and the antichrist. <sup>8</sup> Watch yourselves, so that you may not lose what we have worked for, but may win a full reward. <sup>9</sup> Everyone who goes on ahead and does not abide in the teaching of Christ, does not have God. Whoever abides in the teaching has both the Father and the Son. <sup>10</sup> If anyone comes to you and does not bring this teaching, do not receive him into your house or give him any greeting, <sup>11</sup> for whoever greets him takes part in his wicked works.

For Further Discussion....

- What has God used to teach you about love over the course of your life? About truth?
- What does John tell us about how to **spot "deceivers"**? How is the **church to relate** to such deceivers?
- John teaches that the mark of authenticity for the Christian is love. How does John define "love" (6)? Can you give an example of how this works?
- John teaches that the **mark of authenticity** for teachers of the Christian faith is that they confess the **coming of Jesus Christ in the flesh** (7). <u>Why</u> is this at the very **heart of discipleship** for John?
- What happens when we attempt to walk in love without truth?
- What happens when we attempt to walk in truth without love?
- Pray together in light of this week's passage.
