

A Worship Study Guide for Individuals, Groups and Families for the week of January 9, 2022

Divorce

This week, Pastor Steve Shelby preached from Matthew 5:31-32

³¹ "It was also said, 'Whoever divorces his wife, let him give her a certificate of divorce.' ³² But I say to you that everyone who divorces his wife, except on the ground of sexual immorality, makes her commit adultery, and whoever marries a divorced woman commits adultery."

- What makes marriage valuable? What make is so difficult?
- To better understand this week's passage, let's begin with another time recorded in the Gospel of Matthew that Jesus taught about marriage. Read <u>Matthew 19:3-9</u>. At the time of Jesus, one influential Jewish teacher permitted divorce only in extreme cases. Another permitted divorce for any reason. How does this help us <u>understand the Pharisees' "test question"?</u>
- Jesus points us back to <u>Genesis 1:27</u> and <u>2:23-24</u>. What does this teach us about God's design for marriage? (4-6)
- The Pharisees refer to Moses' instructions in <u>Deuteronomy</u>
 24:1-4 about divorce as a "command" (7). What does Jesus reply in verse 8 teach us about divorce?
- How does divorce reveal the hardness of our hearts?
- What similarities and differences do you see between Jesus teaching in Matthew 19:9 and 5:31-32?
- How does Jesus teaching challenge our commonly held views about marriage and divorce?
- Consider that the One teaching is revealed in Scripture as the faithful Bridegroom to His Bride, His Church (i.e. <u>Revelation</u> <u>19:6-7, 9</u>). What does that teach us about the <u>purpose and</u> value of marriage?
- Pray together in light of this week's passage.
