## Your Father & Giving

This week, Pastor Steve Shelby preached from Matthew 6:1-4

"¹Beware of practicing your righteousness before other people in order to be seen by them, for then you will have no reward from your Father who is in heaven. ²Thus, when you give to the needy, sound no trumpet before you, as the hypocrites do in the synagogues and in the streets, that they may be praised by others. Truly, I say to you, they have received their reward. ³But when you give to the needy, do not let your left hand know what your right hand is doing, ⁴ so that your giving may be in secret. And your Father who sees in secret will reward you."

- What contrast does Jesus set up in these verses?
- For Jesus, what is the problem with hypocrisy?
- What does Jesus mean when he says, "when you give to the needy, do not let your left hand know what your right hand is doing" (3)?
- What temptations do you experience in giving? Why?
- It is important to note that Jesus repeatedly refers to God as "your Father". If you know God as your Father, how does that help you to repent of hypocrisy?
- The One teaching here about giving gave everything for us, even when we were at our most needy. His gift was truly only seen by His Father. How does the generosity of God impact your giving?
- Pray together in light of this week's passage.
