



A Worship Study Guide for Individuals, Groups and Families for the week of October 2, 2022

The Wind & The Spirit

- In every worship service, we sing songs to God that help us better understand the sermon. This week, we sang *"Breathe On Me, Breath Of God."* [Listen to the song](#) or [read the lyrics](#). This prayer asks God the Spirit to work in our hearts and lives. **Which verse most stirs you to pray today? Why?**
- This week, **we heard from [Ligdabeth Shea](#)** who shared how Jesus met her, just as He met with Nicodemus. Ligdabeth told us how Jesus led her to believe in Him, and she's been on a wild ride ever since. As Jesus said, *"the wind blows where it wishes"* (8). **What is one surprising twist in your story that you now see was the Spirit of God at work?**
- Every service at WEPC includes a *Confession of Sin*, this week drawn from [The Valley of Vision, "The Spirit's Work"](#). This old Puritan prayer highlights the ministry of our Comforter and Advocate as He leads us to repentance and faith. **What word or phrase from this prayer about the Spirit strikes you today? Why?**
- This week, Pastor Steve Shelby preached from [John 3:1-10](#). **After hearing this week's sermon, how would you describe Who the Holy Spirit is? How is He related to Jesus? What is His role in the New Birth?**
- **Pray that hearts at WEPC will be made new.** Do you need to become a Christian? To be renewed as a follower of Jesus? To change, believe, or to repent? Hint: The answer is "Yes", and you can ask Jesus to meet with you right now!
