The Wind & The Spirit

- In every worship service, we sing songs to God that help us better understand the sermon. This week, we sang "Breathe On Me, Breath Of God." <u>Listen</u> to the song or <u>read the lyrics</u>.
 This prayer asks God the Spirit to work in our hearts and lives.
 Which verse most stirs you to pray today? Why?
- This week, we heard from <u>Ligdabeth Shea</u> who shared how Jesus met her, just as He met with Nicodemus. Ligdabeth told us how Jesus led her to believe in Him, and she's been on a wild ride ever since. As Jesus said, "the wind blows where it wishes" (8). What is one surprising twist in your story that you now see was the Spirit of God at work?
- Every service at WEPC includes a Confession of Sin, this week drawn from The Valley of Vision, "The Spirit's Work". This old Puritan prayer highlights the ministry of our Comforter and Advocate as He leads us to repentance and faith. What word or phrase from this prayer about the Spirit strikes you today? Why?
- This week, Pastor Steve Shelby preached from <u>John 3:1-10</u>.
 After hearing this week's sermon, how would you describe Who the Holy Spirit is? How is He related to Jesus? What is His role in the New Birth?
- Pray that hearts at WEPC will be made new. Do you need to become a Christian? To be renewed as a follower of Jesus? To change, believe, or to repent? Hint: The answer is "Yes", and you can ask Jesus to meet with you right now!
